#### About the Position

Safety Net Hospitals for Pharmaceutical Access (SNHPA) seeks a junior attorney to assist SNHPA with legislative and regulatory advocacy in the area of health policy and drug pricing. The position is located in SNHPA's headquarters in Washington, D.C.

#### Responsibilities

Assisting SNHPA's General Counsel, Director of Legal and Regulatory Affairs, and Director of Government Relations with:

- Drafting letters, talking points and other policy-related documents in support of SNHPA's legislative and regulatory initiatives
- Participating with senior SNHPA staff in interactions and advocacy efforts directed towards influencing federal policy with respect to the 340B drug discount program and related federal programs
- Researching and analyzing issues pertaining to pharmaceutical pricing and federal programs affecting drug pricing, particularly the federal 340B program
- Assisting in keeping hospitals abreast of issues and developments relevant to the 340B and Medicare Part D prescription drug programs, and pharmaceutical manufacturer patient assistance programs
- Helping to draft updates of essential member educational materials
- Providing technical assistance to SNHPA members on matters relating to the 340B program and compliance with programmatic standards and requirements
- Assisting as needed in developing materials supportive of disputes against drug manufacturers relating to pricing and litigation against various parties on 340B issues

#### Qualifications

Candidates should have at least two years of legal experience and an understanding of pharmaceutical policy, Medicare, Medicaid, and hospital issues. Strong writing and communications skills are a must. Experience at a private law firm, national trade association or the federal/state government is a plus. Salary commensurate with experience.
